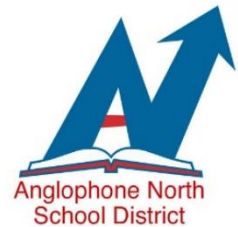

Summary of Accountabilities

- Responsible for the operation of a heavy motor vehicle to safely transport students to and from schools and activities.
- Includes the safe, efficient operation of a school bus, some knowledge of the mechanical operation of a bus and the responsibility for maintaining a mechanically sound vehicle.
- The names of successful applicants, once trained, will be placed on a replacement driver list, and may be called to work on an as-required basis.
- School bus drivers typically work a few hours in the morning and a few hours in the afternoon (Monday-Friday). Drivers do not work on weekends, statutory holidays, summer break, Christmas break, March break & snow days, however, extra hours may be available if desired (school field trips, after school events, weekend sport tournaments, etc.).

Qualifications

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Valid driver's license with a clean driving record and good medical history (no heart conditions).
- Strong focus on safety, along with excellent interpersonal and communication skills.

Training & Licensing Requirements

Selected candidates must complete a **five-day District training course** from **February 24-28, 2025**, in Bathurst, NB.

To operate a school bus, a **Class 2BE driver's license** is required. If you do not currently hold one, we provide all necessary training to help you obtain it. The process includes:

- Completing a **five-day training course**.
- Obtaining a **clean criminal record check, vulnerable sector check, driver's abstract**, and passing a **vision test**.
- Passing both a **written test** and a **road test**.
- Once a **Class 2BE license** is obtained, we offer **paid behind-the-wheel training** and **reimbursement for most licensing costs**.

Employment with Anglophone North offers:

- 4-hour minimum call-in
- Typically, the same model of bus (automatic transmission)
- Potential to park the bus at your home, or a nearby depot
- An average day consists of a morning shift and an afternoon shift
- Casual bus drivers can pick and choose work assignments
