Overview:

This role is ideal for individuals looking for flexible work, as you will be called upon to cover shifts as needed, ensuring the safe and efficient transportation of students to and from school.

Key Responsibilities:

- Safely operate a school bus along designated routes.
- Ensure students' safety and well-being while on the bus.
- Perform pre-trip and post-trip inspections of the vehicle.
- Maintain communication with school staff and parents as required.
- Ensure adherence to traffic laws and safety regulations.
- Report any mechanical issues or incidents in a timely manner.
- Maintain a clean and safe bus environment.

Requirements:

- Driver's license with a clear driving record and ability to pass a background check.
- A good medical record with no heart conditions.
- Experience driving buses or large vehicles is preferred but not essential.
- Strong communication skills and a friendly, patient demeanor with children.
- Flexibility to work on a casual, on-call basis.
- Ability to remain calm and handle challenging situations when necessary.

Selected candidates will be required to complete a 5-day District training course and provide a clean criminal record check, vulnerable sector check, driver's abstract, vision test, written test, and road test. To operate a school bus, a Class 2BE driver's license is required. If you do not currently hold a Class 2BE license, the training provided will assist you in obtaining one. Upon receiving the Class 2BE license, we offer paid behind-the-wheel training and reimbursement for most licensing costs. The date for the next training course has not yet been determined, but it is expected to occur in the spring of 2025.
