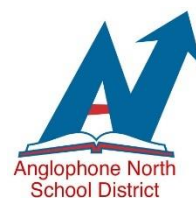

Qualifications

Certified and Retired Teachers

- Must hold a university undergraduate degree (minimum 120 credit hours), or
- Be currently enrolled in a recognized multi-year Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) program, with at least two years (60 credit hours) completed.
- Priority will be given to applicants who hold, or are eligible to hold, a valid New Brunswick Teacher's Certificate.

Local Permit Teachers

- Must have completed a minimum of two years of post-secondary education (diploma or equivalent).

All applicants must be eligible to work in Canada. Candidates with valid work permits are responsible for reviewing and adhering to the conditions outlined in their permit.

Preferred Qualifications and Attributes

We are looking for individuals who:

- Have experience working with children and youth.
- Are committed to creating safe, welcoming, and inclusive classrooms for all students.
- Demonstrate strong organizational and communication skills.
- Are punctual, professional, and dependable.
