As the successful candidate you will provide leadership across all schools of the district within areas of assigned responsibility as member of the curriculum and instruction team. The coordinator will supervise instructional lead teachers, work collaboratively with principals within the areas of assigned responsibility, coordinate assessment, instructional programs, resources, and the implementation of research evidence based instructional practices, curriculum implementation. When required or requested the coordinator will identify, develop, and deliver professional learning for principals, teachers, and staff, and will support the delivery of programs that enhance student performance.
