DISTRICT REGULATION 209

SUBJECT:	<u>Lead Positions</u>
EFFECTIVE:	April 15, 2019
REVISED:	February 12, 2026
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DEFINITION: Leads will be considered “reassigned” from their school for a maximum of two (2) years. After two (2) years, a Lead can be renewed by mutual consent of the parties (member and school district) and will be considered “reassigned” from a teaching position within the Education Center of their original school.

REGULATION:

1. Posting Positions:

- Lead positions will be posted internally to ASD-N teachers via email.
- All teachers are eligible and encouraged to apply/re-apply for lead positions.
- Priority will be given to permanent B contract teachers for lead roles.
- Consideration will be given to those who have not had an opportunity to work in a lead role

2. Supervision:

- Leads will report to the appropriate Subject Area Coordinator.
- Subject Area Coordinators are responsible for the assignment of tasks, monitoring of performance, and attendance of Leads.
- Individuals will be reviewed on a yearly basis to ensure they are able to adequately provide support to teachers.
- Directors, in conjunction with Subject Coordinators, will make decisions which will keep in mind the spirit of the program and what is best for the district.

3. Reassignment as defined by the NBTF/EECD:

4. Final approval for any decision rests with the Superintendent.
