Responsibilities include:

- Facilitate district-wide PLCs and common assessment development for physical education educators
- Lead the organization of District-based sporting events at the elementary and middle school levels, including scheduling competitions, assigning and managing officials, recruiting and organizing volunteers, securing venues, and handling event logistics
- Provide specialized training to educators and assist with certification (i.e. First Aid, Canoeing, Climbing, Archery, Coaching and Officiating)
